

Needs Assessment (NA)

• The tasks here focus on identifying and articulating the purpose and goals of the project, as well as identifying and understanding the project stakeholders. Activities contribute to the development of the business case, and subsequent charter for the project. Even if a project manager is not yet assigned, they should review this information to determine that the purpose, goals, and objectives are clear prior to proceeding with planning

Business Analysis Planning

This includes planning for requirements elicitation, management, and approval, as well as communications and version control.
